₹583 Crore Omnitech IPO

The fresh issue portion of the IPO is planned to raise funds for business expansion and to improve the balance sheet of the company, whereas the OFS will enable the company to dilute its partial equity stake held by the existing shareholders.



Omnitech Engineering is gearing up to raise funds from the primary markets through a book-built public issue worth ₹583 crore, opening for subscription on February 25 and closing on February 27, 2026. This IPO comes at a time when investors are becoming increasingly choosy about new listings. The price band has been set between ₹216 to ₹227 per share, giving the company a pre-IPO market capitalisation of ₹2,807.17 crore at the upper end of the price band. The tentative listing date is March 5 on both BSE and NSE. For retail investors, the minimum number of shares to be applied for is 66 shares, requiring an investment of ₹14,982 at the higher price band. For non-institutional investors, the minimum application size varies from ₹2.09 lakh (sNII) to over ₹10 lakh (bNII). GIFT NIFTY

Opens 60 points positive today



The initial trend indicates that Nifty 50 is likely to open in the green on Wednesday, driven by positive global cues and overnight stability in US markets.

Traders usually keep a close eye on GIFT Nifty as a pre-market indicator to assess market sentiment before the opening of domestic markets.

A premium in GIFT Nifty over domestic futures usually indicates buying interest in the early trade, although the final opening might be adjusted based on institutional inflows and global events closer to the opening bell.

“GIFT Nifty acts as a directional indicator for the Indian market, but for sustained momentum, participation from the cash market is required,” said a derivatives analyst at a Mumbai-based brokerage firm.

Overnight movements in US equities and Asian markets appeared stable, offering a supportive backdrop. Investors are also tracking crude oil prices, US bond yields and currency movements, all of which can influence risk appetite in emerging markets like India.
